

MASTODON TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

FALL CLEAN UP

Mastodon Township is having a fall clean-up for its residents.

Fall clean-up day will be Saturday, October 1, 2022 from 9 a.m. to noon.

We will have one 30-yard GFL (GAD) dumpster for discards, one 20-yard Tru-Recycling dumpster for metal and one Tru-Recycling trailer for tires at the Township Hall, 1371 Hwy. U.S. 2 South.

Residents will be required to show proof of residency: i.e., driver's license or state I.D., voter registration card, or utility bill in resident's name with a Mastodon Township address. Person's claiming to be hauling for a resident must have a written statement from the resident with their name and address stating that is their intent to have you do so.

THE GFL DUMPSTER WILL ACCEPT: items such as furniture, sofas, small appliances, old clothing, toilets, sinks, counter tops, cabinets, siding, small pieces of wood (4 ft. or less), any non-hazardous waste.

TRU-RECYCLING DUMPSTER WILL ACCEPT: Scrap metal, kitchen appliances, refrigerators-freezers-air conditioners with freon removed, household batteries including lithium, vehicle batteries.

TRU-RECYCLING TRAILER WILL ACCEPT: Tires without rims.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT: Any electronics, mattresses, yard waste (grass clippings-leaves-branches), glass, mirrors, storm doors with windows, loose used roofing shingles, any hazardous materials (paints, stains, pesticides, oil), fluorescent bulbs, asbestos, household garbage, treated wood, building materials.
